CONFESSON

All: Almighty God, to You all hearts are open, all desires known, and from You no secrets are hid; cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love You, and rightly honour your holy name; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Leader: Our Lord Jesus Christ said: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbour as

yourself. All the law and prophets hang on these two commandments.”

All: Lord, have mercy on us, and write these your commandments in our hearts and minds to keep them. Amen.

Leader: Brothers and sisters in Christ, Holy Scripture teaches that we are to examine our lives before we take part in the holy fellowship of the Lord’s Supper. God, in his infinite love and mercy, gave his only beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to die for us sinners, on the cross. He atoned there for our sins, that we might become God’s children by adoption and grace and have everlasting life. We have come to remember Christ’s death and all that it means, as He himself instructed. But before we do this we must judge ourselves, we must repent of the sins we have committed, we must firmly trust in Christ our Saviour and above all we must praise and thank Him for his great love for us.

We, who truly and earnestly repent of our sins, come near with faith and take this holy sacrament to strengthen us in our daily lives. But first let us confess our sins to Almighty God together:

All: Almighty God, creator of the universe and judge of all, we confess that we have sinned against You, in thought, word, and deed. We have not loved You as we ought, we have not loved our neighbours as ourselves, and we are sinners by nature. Most merciful God through your Son our Lord Jesus Christ, forgive us all the evil we have done, and the good we have left undone, and grant that we serve and please You from this time forward, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Leader: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, through the sacrifice of Your Son Jesus Christ You have promised forgiveness of sins to all who truly repent and firmly trust in Him; have mercy on us, pardon and deliver us from all our sins and strengthen us to do Your will; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Heavenly Father, give us grace that we continue in that holy fellowship and do all the good works You have prepared for us and our children. We pray this in Jesus' name. Amen.
